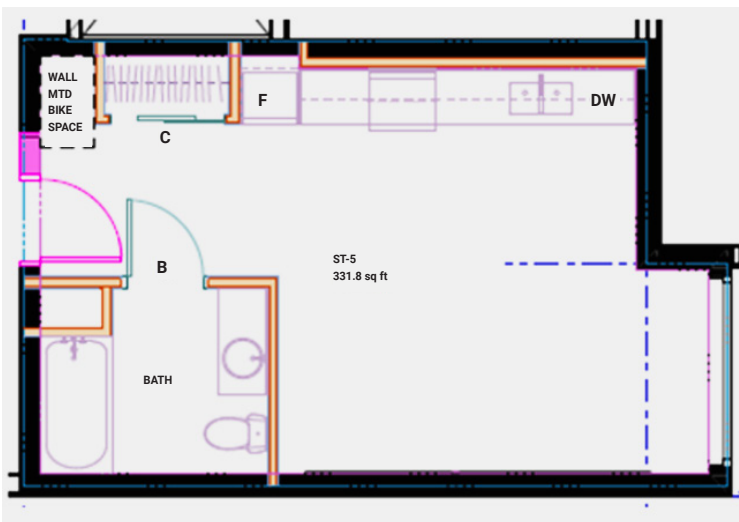




## Youth-centered Solutions

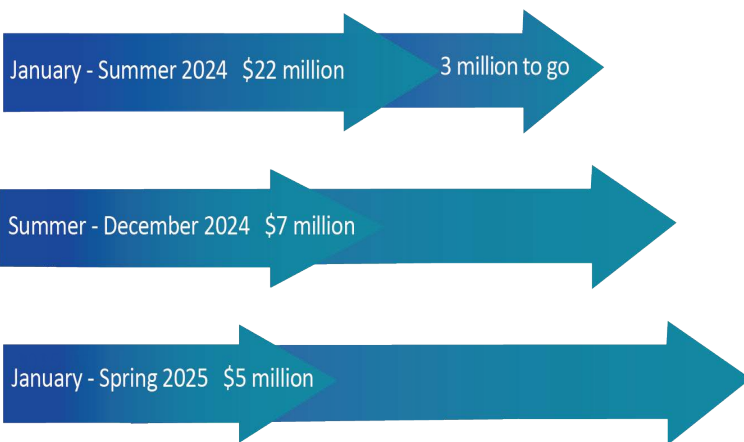
The Constellation Center will increase our capacity for young people and our partners with classrooms, offices, meeting rooms, a computer lab, and a café.

Together with YouthCare's Constellation Center, Community Roots Housing is developing an affordable housing building with 84 units for a total of 80,000 sq. ft. available to young people who qualify.
